Waterfront Support 2019 - Job Description

June 30 – July 27, 2019 at Hardisty Lake Camp

Waterfront Support position works with the Waterfront Coordinator and is responsible for:

- the organization and safety of swimming and canoeing programs as well as for the water front area and equipment.
- Actively teaching and implementing the canoeing program which is an integral component to the Hardisty Lake Camp program.
- ensuring that all procedures, practices and policies are being adhered to while all waterfront activities are taking place.
- being familiar with camp emergency procedures, respecting and complying with all camp policies and procedures
- be an enthusiastic participant in camp activities -- leading campers by example.

Other tasks may include, but are not limited to:

- taking part in the registration process for each camp
- welcoming campers
- camp orientation for campers
- daily chore assignments
- assisting Program Counselors with the implementation of activities
- serving meals
- cleaning cabins

The Waterfront Support position is directly responsible to the Waterfront Coordinator & Summer Camp Director.

All staff who work at a camp enjoy working with children and youth ages 6-17. Staff are enthusiastic and excited facilitators of a safe and fun summer camp for all participants.

All camp staff and campers remain at the camp site during camp, unless permission to leave is granted by the Summer Camp Director. All leadership team members are available to help each other as needed.

All staff promote a Christian community, based on United Church belief, in which we are all treated with respect to make each camp experience a unique and fulfilling one for all participants. This position is deemed to be a level 2 risk assessment with a high level of responsibility and authority for the safety and well-being of campers.

Qualifications:

- must be a minimum age of 16 years on the first day of camp
- Standard First Aid certification
- current Level 2 police check
- Social Services Intervention Check
- National Lifeguard Services (NLS) certification – an asset but not mandatory
- Current Canoe Instructors certification or willing to take course
- available for staff training sessions

Remuneration:

- \$600.00 per week (max. 5 weeks) includes room and board
